

<p>Discuss what a hurricane is. Then create a STEM hurricane. Share with a buddy class. How do hurricane's effect communities?</p>	<p>Create cards to give to the firefighters fighting the fires in Montana, Idaho and/or Oregon.</p>	<p>Read Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs. Students can then create a presentation on weather and/or a natural disaster. This can be a poster or hands-on demonstration. Share with a buddy class.</p>	<p>Discuss Mexico and the recent earthquake. Create a STEM activity on earthquakes. On a pan of Jell-O build an earthquake resistant house. Then give it a mighty shake. How did you do? Write a letter or create a video to a school in Mexico.</p>	<p><a href="#">Celebrating Diversity with Elmer</a> Students will discuss Elmer's similarities and differences when compared with all of the other elephants. Students will discuss their own similarities and differences and will celebrate those differences together. Can you find another school to share with?
