What does the PTA do?

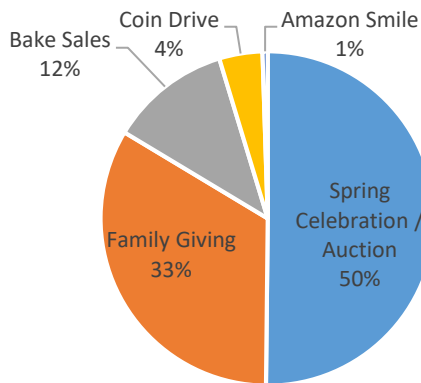

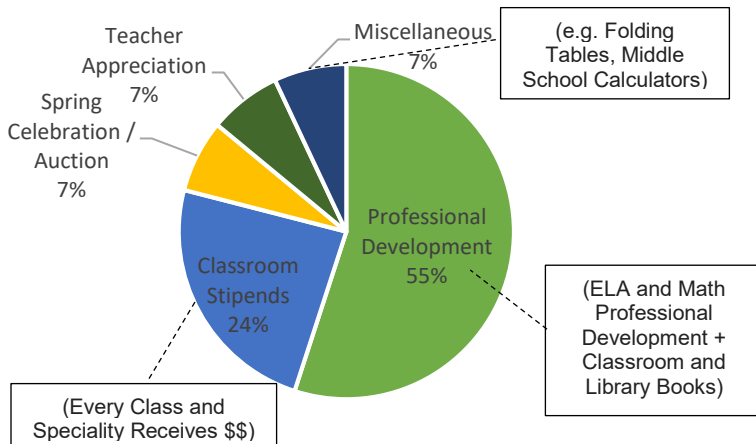
How does the PTA fundraise?
