Dear Parents and Shuang Wen School Families:

The overall 6th grade theme is developing and maintaining a positive learning community. In ELA we are reading about the lives of people who have shown great persistence, in the midst of tremendous challenges, such as the singer Ray Charles and the basketball player Jeremy Lin, who have made contributions to promote making sound choices in their own lives and communities. We're having a wonderful time listening to music, watching basketball videos, reading, writing and discussing. We will be

visiting the Ancient Civilization exhibits at the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Museum of Natural History to learn about ancient communities. In Math we are applying multi-step problem solving relationships among 2 D & 3 D figures in Geometry. In Chinese language classes students are using conversational language to discuss sports including learning how to do the exercise - Tai chi. We are also writing formal letters to communicate with elder generations. This month in science students have been learning about how living things are all dependent on each other in an ecosystem. We co-constructed a list of plants and animals that live in New York. Then we put together a food chain showing how the diets of everything on our list are connected and dependent on each other. We also dissected owl pellets to learn about what barn owls eat and depend on in their own food chain. In SEL students are viewing inspirational videos about positive character on how best to be kinder students and people.
