Dear Parents/Guardians,

The staff of The Cobble Hill School of American Studies is committed to preparing young people for leadership and professional roles in college and community. In keeping with this mission, we strongly advise our students to dress in a responsible manner, appropriate for an educational environment. This is particularly important during the spring and summer months.

Appropriate attire for young men and women covers the torso and consists of pants/shorts/skirts that are longer than 2 inches above the knee and pants that do not sag 2 inches below the waist. Any tights/leggings must be worn with a shirt that falls at least 8 inches below the waist. In addition, all shirts/blouses must cover the shoulders, torso and back. No marina or sleeveless tank tops are permitted. Torn jeans must be worn with leggings if tears are above the knees. As always, caps, hats, "do-rags" and other forms of head apparel may not be worn in school. These items should be placed in book bags before students enter the school building.

Please be advised this regulation will be strictly enforced and that students wearing inappropriate articles of clothing will be removed from the educational environment and parents/guardians will be notified and required to report to school to deliver appropriate attire.
