Ask to review the more difficult sections!▪ If you believe that that no matter the prep, your test-taking skills aren't an accurate measure of your college readiness, check out SAT optional schools:http://www.fairtest.org/university/optional▪ Sign up to take the ACT, which includes English, Math, Reading, and Science. Colleges accept both exams. Comparison chart: http://www.studydrive.com/ed/act-vs-sat/▪ Take the exam twice! Colleges will Super Score, meaning they take the highest score from each section.
