Dear 8th Grade Families,

In collaboration with *Greenspring Tours*, Westlake Middle School is excited to participate on an eighth grade trip to Washington, D.C. from May 15th-17th, 2019. **Please return the attached permission slip/medical authorization to the Main Office by Friday, October 19th.**

The cost of the trip is \$620 based on quad occupancy, which includes four students in a room. There is a significant charge added per student for rooms of less than four. Five students per room will not be permitted. This cost includes transportation, chaperones, nursing, accommodations, all meals and admission/ticket fees.

If your child will be attending the trip, a deposit of \$300 is required by Friday, October 19th. Payments can be made directly to *Greenspring Tours*. Log-on to www.greenspringtours.com, click on "Pay Now" and enter Westlake Middle School under "Group Name". If your last name is different from your child's, please also add in your child's last name in parentheses. Should you have any questions about payment, contact Karen at *Greenspring Tours*: 1-800-447-5081.

To offset the cost of the trip, students have the opportunity to participate in a cookie dough and popcorn fundraiser called *Miss Chocolate*. A representative from the company will be here on Tuesday, October 2 to speak with all students during lunch. 40% of your child's sales will be credited towards the cost of the trip, thereby reducing the final payment. We encourage all students to take advantage of this opportunity to offset the cost of the trip.

Final payment for the trip must be made by Friday, December 14th. You will be notified of the final amount due, which will depend upon your child's participation in the fundraiser. If there are families who are experiencing financial difficulties which affect your ability to pay for this trip, please contact your child's guidance counselor, Bill Keogh at ext. 2603.

There will be an informational meeting on Tuesday, March 12th for parents at 7:00 p.m. in the LGI. The schedule and other important details about this trip will be discussed. Attached, please find a tentative itinerary for the trip.

Participating in extra-curricular activities is a privilege. Student behavior needs to be appropriate at all times and students need to demonstrate a sense of pride and leadership in representing Westlake Middle School. Students with repeated or serious offenses or whose behavior does not improve will not be allowed to attend the eighth grade trip.

**IV. NEW YORK STATE NO-FAULT LAW
PERTAINING TO SCHOOL BUSES**
