



Do You Need to Catch-up on Required Immunizations (Shots)?



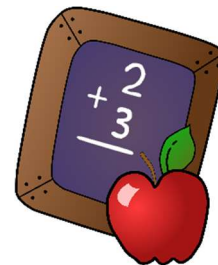

Why should children get vaccinated?

- Vaccines not only protect you and your family but also protect the health of people where you live, especially those who cannot get shots due to health conditions or are too young.
- New State Law:
 - Starting this school year in New York State, any non-medical reason to not get all vaccinations, is no longer accepted. Religious exemptions are no longer allowed.
 - This new law requires all students in public, private, and religious schools from daycare through grade 12 to be immunized.
