The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the school schedule for Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>. As noted on the District calendar, the PSAT / NMSQT (National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) will be administered on October 10<sup>th</sup>. Sophomores and Juniors may take this examination, which is approximately 3 hours in length. Sophomores and Juniors will arrive at the normal time to begin the PSAT exam at 8:30. The lunch period will be extended for students taking the examination as needed.

**Important Information for Freshman and Seniors:**

- Freshman and Seniors will be on a delayed schedule. Buses will begin picking up at 10:45 am to arrive at school at 11:26.
- There will be no AM Boces classes for Juniors and Seniors

**Important Information for Juniors:**

- See the attached pre-administration schedule
- The examination is used to determine students' eligibility for scholarships through the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.
- Students receive feedback on areas of strength and in need of improvement relative to successful studies in college.
- The examination is an opportunity for practice prior to taking the SAT.
- The cost of the examination is \$16.00. Payment may be made via cash or a check / money order may be made payable to the Nanuet Union Free School District.

**Important Information for Sophomores:**

- The District is providing all students in the Class of 2021 the opportunity to take this examination.
- The examination provides students practice before taking the PSAT / NMSQT in their junior year, when the test is used for potential scholarship purposes.
- We are continually looking at data, which provide us important information about students' academic abilities. The data are used to help the students, parents, and counselors make appropriate choices regarding course selection throughout high school.
- The District is covering the cost of the examination for members of the Class of 2021.

Results and feedback should be available to students in early December.
