ACADEMIC LEAGUE

PURPOSE: To foster competition on an academic level, answering questions related to high school curriculum, current events, and trivia.

ACTIVITIES: Interscholastic matches plus a county tournament using a "College Bowl" format with lighted buzzer boards, 4-person teams.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP:

Strong academic background, interest in a few key areas and some trivia, and quick reaction to questions.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP:

The Mathematics Department of Nanuet Senior High School sponsors a chapter of Mu Alpha Theta (Math), a National High School and Junior College Mathematics Honor Society. To be eligible for membership a student must:

- a) have completed three years of College Preparatory Mathematics (Honors or Regents).
- b) be currently enrolled in a fourth year of College Prep Math (or have completed Math 12).
- c) have achieved a final grade of A for all regents level Math courses taken.
- d) have achieved a final grade of B+ or greater for all honors level Math courses taken.

MUSIC TECHNOLOGY CLUB

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP:

There is no grade requirement, but students must play at least one varsity sport. Students must be drug and alcohol free for a minimum of one year.

Being outgoing and unafraid to speak to groups is helpful. Applications are accepted at the beginning of the year, which starts the application process. An information meeting is held in late September to give out applications.
