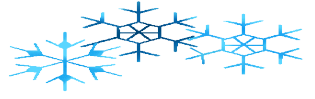

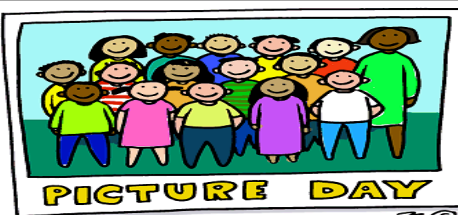
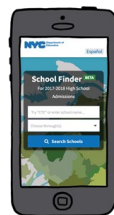
8th GRADE

BLUE EMERGENCY CARDS

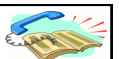
