Writing - We would like you to write your life story. What makes you special and unique? What do you love to do? What do you avoid? What has happened in your life that you want to share and celebrate? Share with us some of your experiences that have made you who you are today. You may illustrate your writing piece so that it looks like an illustrated novel or a picture book, if you wish.

You can also draw a timeline of your life.

Dual Language/Polish-Choose your favorite legend or your favorite story. Describe at least one character and his/her major character trait. Is the character brave? ambitious? hardworking? Explain. You can also illustrate or make comic book (using frames to separate each thought).
