



Supply List for First Grade


- 3 two pocket folders (1 red and the others of your choice)

- 12 **SHARPENED** pencils (No mechanical pencils please!)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 hardcover marble notebook
- 2 packs of black Expo dry erase markers
- A pencil box/bag large enough to hold all of these supplies
- Headsets for computer time
- Box of tissues for classroom use
