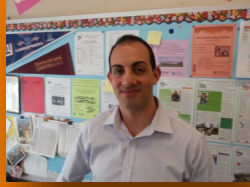
(Resources for you and your family!)

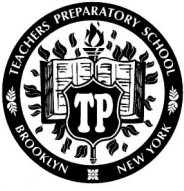

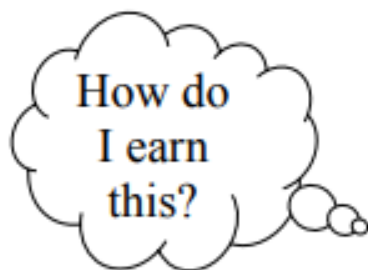

TPS Dollars	REDEEMABLE FOR
4 TPS Scholar 	<p><b>\$1 Discount</b> on school events, ex: parties, games, special events and whatever we "deem" feasible.</p> <p>Students can <b>ONLY</b> present <b>ONE TPS \$1</b> per event. Some exceptions may apply. <b>Please check with program organizers for other restrictions.</b></p> <p><b>Attendance snacks:</b> if you are on the perfect attendance list.</p>
10 TPS Scholar 	<p><b>Homework pass</b> (See your subject teacher - this is at your teacher's discretion)</p>
20 TPS Scholar 	<p><b>BIRTHDAY DRESS DOWN DAY</b></p> <p>You <b>MUST</b> also show proof of ID card and meet attendance, academic, behavior and dress code requirements. <b>Must be done at least five days in advance.</b></p> 
100 TPS Scholar 	<p><b>Gift Certificate</b> (attendance team)</p>  

You can earn TPS dollars on a daily/weekly basis for the following:



- Get to school at or before 8:20AM
- Come to school
- Wear your school dress code/uniform
- Swipe your ID card
- Show citizenship
- Exhibit positive behavior
- Etc.



Additional ways to earn TPS dollars:

- Student of the month: **two TPS dollars**
- Maintaining an **85** or above average at the end of the semester: **five TPS dollars**
- **100%** attendance for the semester (no lateness): **five TPS dollars**



TPS dollars can on be redeemed **ON THE DAY THAT ANNOUNCEMENTS ARE MADE. YOU MUST LISTEN CAREFULLY TO MORNING ANNOUNCEMENTS OR YOU WILL MISS OUT.**

For special events, you **MUST** redeem your TPS dollars at least **24 hours prior** to the event. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** A receipt will be given to you upon redeeming your TPS dollar.

**Save your TPS dollars for bigger prizes!** (TPS dollars from prior school year are not acceptable.)

**LOOK OUT FOR ADDITIONAL REDEEMABLE REWARDS.**
