Security Updates/Fund A Need- I have been working with different groups at the school to make sure this gets done and gets done properly. A company by the name of Security Solutions have been picked and will be working on the updates shortly. Some of the updates you will see from them, new access control on all doors except 6 by the liberal arts wing which will all be re-keyed, a badging system for all staff, cameras outside of the school as well as one inside of the new gymnasium, a new AI phone (the phone on Mrs. Coonrod's desk that unlocks the door) on Mrs. Bernstein's desk to help with office flow. From BHS, new doors on the exterior kitchen door, Mrs. Jueneman's classroom door, Mrs. O'Haver's office door. These door's are out of compliance with the Salina Diocese and are a safety issue with no glass window on the door. If funds allow, we will also be looking into adding a window blind on all teacher doors to comply with RCPD's recommendation IF someone was to get it, the teachers could cover the glass. The windows will stay uncovered at all times unless a drill.
