As part of the Safe Environment Program for the Diocese of Salina, those who minister with minors in our parishes and schools, including all parish and school employees, are to be educated about the nature of child sexual abuse, how it is perpetrated, how to report it, and strategies for prevention.

The Diocese of Salina currently uses a program called CMGConnet, a web based on-line training program (along with an integrated background check) that specializes in helping parishes and schools and religious organizations create safe environments for children and youth. All high school students who (grades 9-12) who minister with other minors will do their own training through CMGConnect, which covers safe and appropriate ways to interact with other children.
