

Hello! As you all may have heard, our schools are closed for the next few weeks due to the Coronavirus. Please have your child work on the following at home if our schools are closed:

1) Storyworks text("I Live in a Refugee Camp) with packet. If your child cannot print this work, just have them complete the work on looseleaf paper or any other paper that you have available. Another option is to type everything on Google Docs and share the document with me online. Please have them label every page carefully (name, title of text, name of worksheet) so I know which page goes with each set of questions or activities.

To access the story, "I Live in a Refugee Camp", please follow the steps below:

- * Go to the website <https://storyworks.scholastic.com/>.
- * Click on the login button.
- * Click on "I am a student".
- * The classroom password is wardobligado. Type that in.
- * Click on the December 2019/January 2020 issue
- * Click on the article, "I Live in a Refugee Camp". This will give you access to the story to read online.

*Your child was assigned another Storyworks article, "The Snake That is Eating Florida" and a packet for homework. Please make sure they continue working on that as well.

2) Have your child log into Raz-Kids and work on reading texts and answering questions from this website. Try to have them read a mix of fiction and nonfiction texts throughout the week.

- * Go to <https://www.raz-kids.com/>
- * Click on the green button labeled Kids Login.
- * Type in aobligado for teacher name.
- * Click on your child's name.
- * Type in the password: obligado

3) Instead of the Wordly Wise, Lesson 7 quiz, have your child write a story using at least 10 different words in lesson 7. It is the same format as the lesson 6 story they wrote last month. Have your child write their story on Google Docs or on looseleaf. Please have them label it with their name and Wordly Wise, Lesson 7 story. If they type on Google Docs, make sure they share it with Mrs. Obligado.

4) Rally Math Test Prep Packet: do a few pages every day.

5) Your child should practice their math skills on Dreambox Learning.

* Click on the green login button in the upper right corner.

* Username is the same as their log in for the Chromebooks.

* Password is their lunch number.

6) Dynamath articles and activities- have them complete the work in any blank space available in the packet.

7) Decimal word problem packet. There are 65 questions. Please do a few a day. Answers are given on the last page. Students must show work for every problem and can use the answers to check for accuracy.

In the event that we are closed for longer, We will be sending another email with more work for your child to complete. Please make sure to check your emails regularly .
