Buildings and Grounds Committee Meeting Minutes

- A. David Valcin called meeting to order at 8:35am
- B. Brian made a motion to approve minutes from April 26th, David seconded, 3 in favor, David B abstain
- C. **Spring Work Update:**
- Most of field is done and fence line cleaned. Question about using town fields if needed.
 - Ryan will remove shrubs. Eric confirmed they should come out.
 - Brian still waiting on a price from Peerless for stump grinding. Haupt price - \$1546 for 2 stumps. Would like to get 1 done before graduation.
 - Chris emailed information on the doors - \$4257 for the 2 doors in lower building. Burlington Construction \$5894 (includes lights). David made a motion to accept CLC Building & Design estimate of \$4257, David B seconded all in favor.
 - The walkway ceiling (\$3966 Material, \$3200 Labor). In looking closer, we could refurbish what is there. Ron Jones is coming today to give a price.
 - Chalkboard paint is on 1 door in each bathroom. Brian will look into how to keep the chalk and eraser in each stall.
- D. **Other B & G:**
- Sharon Electric will terminate last 2 broken bollards.
 - AC Engineering- Salamone & Associates will be coming May 17th for visit, Bid docs ready May 31st, Bidding early June, Construction July, Completion August 16th.
 - Will AC in all classrooms prevent need for heat related dismissals? Not at this time, as decisions are made as a region.
 - Floor estimate from R&M - \$4480 each bathroom. Brian is getting 1-2 more estimates.
 - 6 signs for playground/fields are here and need to be put up. Committee will look at placement.
 - Brian will call Perotti and see what can be done about PK water fountain.
 - Brian will call the striper and arrange for signs. Thoughts about circle and entrance times. Should it be limited hours or no entry at all? We will bring this to the safety committee on May 15th.
 - New lobby bathroom signs will be put up next week.
 - Meeting last week with Eric was productive.
 - Eric looked at tree damage on May 2nd.
