

SALISBURY BOARD OF EDUCATION -1- REGULAR MEETING JUNE 25, 2018 FINAL

Call to Order: Mr. Valcin called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.

Spotlight on Learning: ASCD: Empower 18 – Mr. Reilly and Ms. Gaschel-Clark gave a presentation on their experience attending the ASCD: Empower 18 conference held in Boston this past spring.

BOE Recognition: Mrs. Pat Stevens and Mr. Brian Shippa were recognized for their contributions to Salisbury Central School. Mr. Shippa was not in attendance but Mrs. Stevens thanked the BOE for the honor and for their support.

There will be no recognitions during the August meeting but there will be nominations for recognitions for the September meeting.

Consent Agenda: Mr. Bayersdorfer requested that the minutes of the May 21st meeting be pulled out of the consent agenda for discussion.

The consent agenda was approved by a vote of 3-0 (Mr. Valcin, Mr. Prinz, Ms. Hayhurst – Yes; Mr. Bayersdorfer, Ms. Rice – Abstained).

Mr. Bayersdorfer requested that the minutes of the May 21st regular meeting be amended to include the discussion regarding the number of students attending private schools rather than HVRHS and his request for a breakdown of where the members of the Class of 2018 will be attending high school. The distribution of graduates was confirmed as 26 attending HVRHS, 10 attending private schools, 1 attending OWT and 2 moving away.

The May 21st minutes were approved unanimously.

Written Communication to the BOE: Mr. Valcin read a thank you note from Ms. Joanne Klein.

Public Comment on Agenda Items: There was none.

School Related Organizations: There were none.

Regional/School/BOE Committee Reports: Region One – Ms. Weigel reported on staffing changes and graduation at HVRHS. The Region One BOE's next regular meeting will be held in September.

ABC Committee – Mr. Valcin reported that the ABC Committee will be meeting on Wednesday, June 27th. The Committee has finalized the Superintendent's job description and evaluation tool. The Salisbury BOE will conduct their evaluation of Dr. Vogel in August/September after she has completed her self-evaluation.

BOE B&G Committee Update – Mr. Valcin reported that the summer renovation, paving/concrete and AC installation projects have begun or will begin next week. The Town Building Committee and Salisbury B&G Committee members will be meeting with Newfield Construction weekly to review how the classroom renovation project is progressing.

Recommendations to Hire – Mrs. Magyar recommended hiring Mrs. Carol Hackett for the .67 FTE middle school science position at a MA/2 step salary of \$34,015.90. Ms. Rice made a motion to approve the hiring of Mrs. Hackett for the 18-19 middle school science position with a salary of \$34,015.90. The motion was seconded by Mr. Bayersdorfer and passed unanimously.

Policy 5118 Resident and Non-Resident Attendance – Mr. Valcin invited the BOE members to consider changing the current Policy 5118 to include the children of non-certified staff working at Salisbury Central. After a brief discussion, it was decided that information about the policies of other Region One schools, the potential number of students this change could add to our enrollment, the financial impact of the change and creating specific guidelines for determining whether or not to grant staff non-resident requests would be gathered and discussed at a future BOE meeting. CABE will also be contacted for guidance.

Administrative Reports: Principal Report – Mrs. Magyar spoke about end of the year events, professional development, grading practices, staffing and the Next Generation Accountability report.

Superintendent Report – Dr. Vogel was unable to attend the meeting. There were no questions about her written report.

Assistant Superintendent Report –Ms. Lisa Carter spoke about grading practices, the Vision of a Graduate plan, the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), the 2018-2019 professional development plan, the Career/Work Experience Program run by Dr. Mary O’Neill and the English Language Program run by Mrs. Celina Huber.

Public Comment on Agenda Items: Ms. Rice read a statement of concerns she has as a member of the BOE regarding a comment made by another BOE member at the May 21st regular meeting. Ms. Rice expressed that she did not appreciate the comment and that she felt it shed a negative light on HVRHS. Ms. Rice suggested that everyone focus on the good work that’s being done at HVRHS of which she shared a number of examples.

Ms. Hayhurst made a motion to go into executive session for the purposes of discussing the proposed 2018-2021 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Salisbury BOE and the SCS non-certified staff inviting in Mrs. Magyar and Mrs. Bucceri. The motion was seconded by Mr. Prinz and passed unanimously

The BOE went into executive session at 7:15 p.m.

The BOE came out of executive session at 7:23 p.m.

Mr. Bayersdorfer made a motion to accept the 2018-2021 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Salisbury BOE and the SCS non-certified staff as presented. The motion was seconded by Ms. Rice and passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:24 pm on a motion made by Ms. Rice.
