## Code-for-a-Cause

This unique introductory coding opportunity, on March 9<sup>th</sup>, is free and open to all fourth through eighth grade students in Region One. **No prior experience is necessary**; lunch, refreshments and door prizes will be provided.

Participants will work with high-school mentors and local non-profits (NPO). Teams of four or five will then conceptualize and design a phone app to assist their NPO in implementing its mission.

Students will be taught MIT APP Inventor, an on-line coding software, and shown how to map out a functional design. The day ends with students presenting their ideas and progress to each other.

As Patrice Gans, founder of RHoK Jr., says: “Participating students work with computer science mentors to create technology for social good. By the end of the day, we hope students see how technology can positively impact someone’s life. In addition, all of the solutions developed will become part of the public domain for others to use at no charge.”
