Dear Parents,

Our Ski Adventure program is fast approaching for our 5th-8th grade students. We have reserved Catamount for the following **Tuesdays: January 7, 14, 21, and 28th.** **We require all students to take lessons and wear helmets.** On the first day, the ski instructors will test students and place them in lessons according to their skiing ability. Armbands will be assigned according to their instruction level. We hope this visual distinction will cut down on injuries and clear up any confusion about which slopes are accessible for which skiers. As you can imagine, this program is a big responsibility and we are making every effort to help ensure everyone's safety. This is a part of our PE program. It is expected that students will participate unless there are **mitigating circumstances.** **Scholarships are available.** Donations toward scholarships are also accepted.

The cost is as follows:

Tickets	\$20.00 X 4 = \$80.00
Rentals	\$21.00 X 4 = \$84.00 (helmets are included in this price!)
Lessons	\$12.50 X 4 = \$50.00 (we require that all students must take lessons)
Grand Total	\$214.00 (for tickets, rentals, and lessons)

If you would like to purchase a SEASON PASS (\$315.00), there is an application attached.

We will be leaving at 1:00 p.m. and returning to S.C.S. at 6:30 p.m. All students are required to ride the bus up to Catamount. Food is available at the lodge, but it is expensive. We recommend bringing snacks with you. Dress in layers! **Heavy gloves, snow pants, and parkas, are required!!** It's no fun to ski if you are cold!
