Policy for serving meals to non-paying full or reduced price students.

All students enrolled at Salisbury Central School have a personal cafeteria account. Our cafeteria computer system is used to record and track purchases made by each student in the school. Parents are able to deposit funds into their child's account using an online payment system or by sending cash or a check to the school.

The school cafeteria's first priority is to ensure that every student at Salisbury Central has access to nutritious meals every day. No student at Salisbury Central will ever be denied something to eat from the cafeteria for breakfast or lunch based on their ability to pay or the balance in their cafeteria account. However, students that owe money to the cafeteria (delinquent debt) will not be allowed to purchase a la cart snacks or ice cream.
