The Art Component

Week of July 9th: Time: 9:00-11:30

Art I--A hands- on art experience with traditional art mediums along with an introduction to famous artists through museum visits in New York City.

Drawing and Acrylic Painting Techniques; visit to the Frick ; visit to Sotheby's, and painting in the park (Central, that is) with pastels.

Week of July 16th:

Art II—Hands-on art experience with focus on fashion and printmaking combined with museum visits.

Students will visit the Metropolitan Museum, learn about fashion design, carve a stamp to design their own tote bag, and experiment with other art mediums.

Students do not need any prior art experience to enroll. Studio Art II can be taken without having taken Studio Art I.
