We all are looking forward to Spring Break, starting after elementary conferences tomorrow (no conferences for Middle School). Middle school teachers will be meeting to plan distance learning strategies if needed. There is no school for all students tomorrow March 13. During the break we will have a bit of time to assess the situation at our school. We are in constant contact with medical professionals, the NM department of Health and the NM Public Education Department about what to do in terms of precautions and large group closures. We plan to finish school today and have conferences and meetings tomorrow, Friday March 13th.

Any changes to that plan will be communicated through the schools' website, and email to all TTCS community groups, and importantly, if there is a change in opening, a "robo call" will be sent out. These are very unusual times and we will do our very best to keep the school as safe and clean as possible. Thank you all for your understanding and cooperation as we work through the school attendance portion of this worldwide pandemic.
