<b>The information below identifies areas where protocols have been either implemented or modified:</b>		
<i>Student Parking</i>	<b><u>ALL</u></b> students will park in the student parking lot (including Work-Based Learning). <b>Student driver dismissal is 2:35 p.m.</b>	
<i>Morning Drop Off</i>	Students will be able to enter the building at 7:15 a.m. Please be aware of this time when dropping students off in the morning. <b>The first bell is 7:40 a.m.</b>	
<i>Check Out Procedures</i>	Please be aware of the need for <b><u>updated phone information</u></b> . Updated phone/address information will be critical in the <b><u>verification call process</u></b> of releasing students.	
<i>Afternoon Parent Pick-up</i>	Parents will continue to pick up students in the Teacher/Staff parking lot (small parking lot, formerly Work-Based Learning parking lot). <b>Parent Pick-up dismissal is 2:30 p.m.</b>	
<i>COVID-19</i>	Please review the COVID-19 information on both the school and district websites.	
<i>Temperature Screening</i>	Students will participate in temperature screenings each morning. If you child's temperature registers over 100.4 after a resting phase and recheck, you will be notified for pick-up.	
<i>Masks</i>	Students will be provided with one mask. Cleanliness of the mask will be the parent's responsibility. Students are asked to wear a mask for their safety and that of others.	
<i>Visitors</i>	As an added safety measure, visitors will be discouraged from frequenting TCHS. Visitors who are scheduled for an appointment/conference must wear a mask.
