- AT LEAST 72 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT MEDICATION

- 10 DAYS HAVE PASSED SINCE SYMPTOMS FIRST APPEARED
(MUST MEET ALL THREE)

MAY RETURN TO WORK/SCHOOL AFTER:
- AT LEAST 24 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT MEDICATION
- AT LEAST 24 HOURS WITHOUT OTHER SIGNIFICANT SYMPTOMS,
(MUST MEET BOTH)

TEST POSITIVE COVID-19

MAY RETURN TO WORK/SCHOOL AFTER:
- 10 DAYS SINCE POSITIVE LAB TEST
- INDIVIDUAL REMAINS ASYMPTOMATIC
(MUST MEET BOTH)

KNOWN EXPOSURE TO PERSON WITH COVID-19

Tattnall County Employee/Workplace Flowchart for COVID-19

To be considered exposed to COVID-19, you need to have prolonged close contact with a person who has the virus. Close contact includes living in the same household, caring for a sick person with the virus, being within 6 feet of a sick person with the virus for at least 15 continuous minutes without the use of a face covering, or being in direct contact with secretions from the sick person.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- “Close contact” includes being directly exposed to infectious secretions (e.g., being coughed on while not wearing a mask) or being within 6 ft. for a duration of 15 minutes while not wearing a mask
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SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 People with these symptoms may have COVID-19

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache
