“The Apple Corps”

A Musical About Traffic Safety In New York City

In this full-scale, interactive, musical theatre production a group of cool, smart, street-wise kids --“The Apple Corps”-- help other kids learn how to get around the city’s streets by making safe choices.

The show contains a series of vignettes in which the kids encounter different traffic situations related to crossing streets, being safe on bikes, skateboards, roller blades and scooters and using safety belts to be safer in a car.

The kids learn how to use their “safety tools” (eyes, ears, hands, feet, brain) to make safety decisions. This fast-paced production relates to kids on their level

and in their language, and is spiced with original songs, contemporary rhythms and dynamic choreography, and enhanced with colorful costumes and scenery.

“The Apple Corps” is a must-see performance, which empowers kids to help themselves and others be safe.

“The Apple Corps” is produced and performed by Flying Ship Productions and based on traffic safety content provided by NYC DOT’s Division of Safety Education and Outreach. This production is funded by the NYC Department of Transportation.
