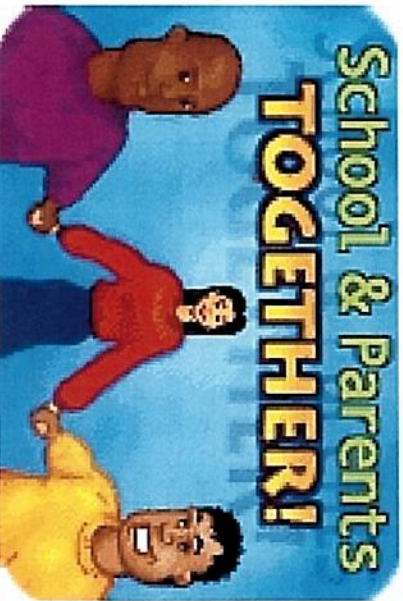

School Overview

The Eagle Academy Model is a maximized educational approach to nurture the "whole" child so that each Eagle Academy student is successful in the classroom and in life. Our goal is to provide the resources so that our young men can achieve their promise as students, as family members, and as engaged citizens in their communities. The result is an intimate, specialized public school, with small class size, trained and committed teachers, and a full complement of in-school and out-of-school programs.

Eagle Academy scholars will experience a **rigorous college prep** curriculum, aligned with common core standards, complete with remediation and acceleration services. In addition, we will have monthly workshops and programs that are designed to **engage parents** in their children's academic lives and provide them with the tools and skills they need to be active and supportive partners.

Extended day learning will be offered to all Eagle Scholars. It will include tutoring, extracurricular activities and a Saturday program held over 25 weekends to aid students in developing life skills and character. All incoming scholars will attend a **summer enrichment** program that will familiarize them with the Eagle culture and expectations. Dedicated men are matched with our scholars to help foster academic and personal growth; scholars will gain additional support and learn to be role models through peer-to-peer **mentoring**. Students will gain a sense of community through Eagle's school-wide uniform policy as well as an appreciation for helping others through opportunities in **service learning**. Finally, Eagle Staten Island will foster a rich cultural component, inclusive of daily meetings, to help scholars unite under a shared set of values and goals aimed at academic excellence.
