BAND – *Grades 5 & 6...Club advisor, Mr. Blanco*

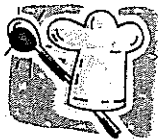
Attending weekly band rehearsals will provide the opportunity to meld the various musical instruments into a cohesive sounding unit to prepare for the spring concert. In addition, rehearsals are vital to the development of one's musicianship and will promote the success of the Lincoln Orens Middle School Band. Grade 5/6 band students are required to attend at least one weekly rehearsal (Monday or Thursday), but are welcome to attend both, if they choose, in order to perform in the spring concert. Failure to attend more than four rehearsals may result in being excluded from the concert. If a student is absent from school, he/she is excused from attending rehearsal on that day.

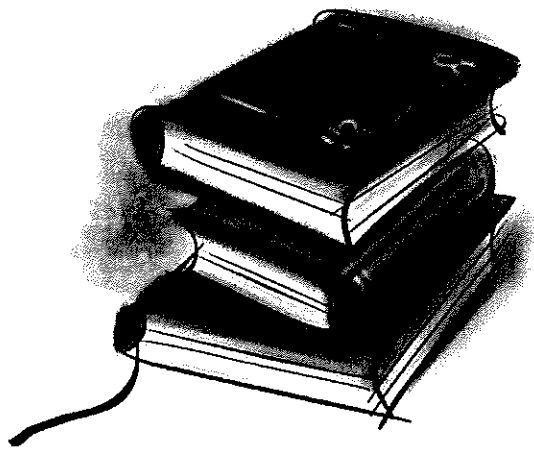
