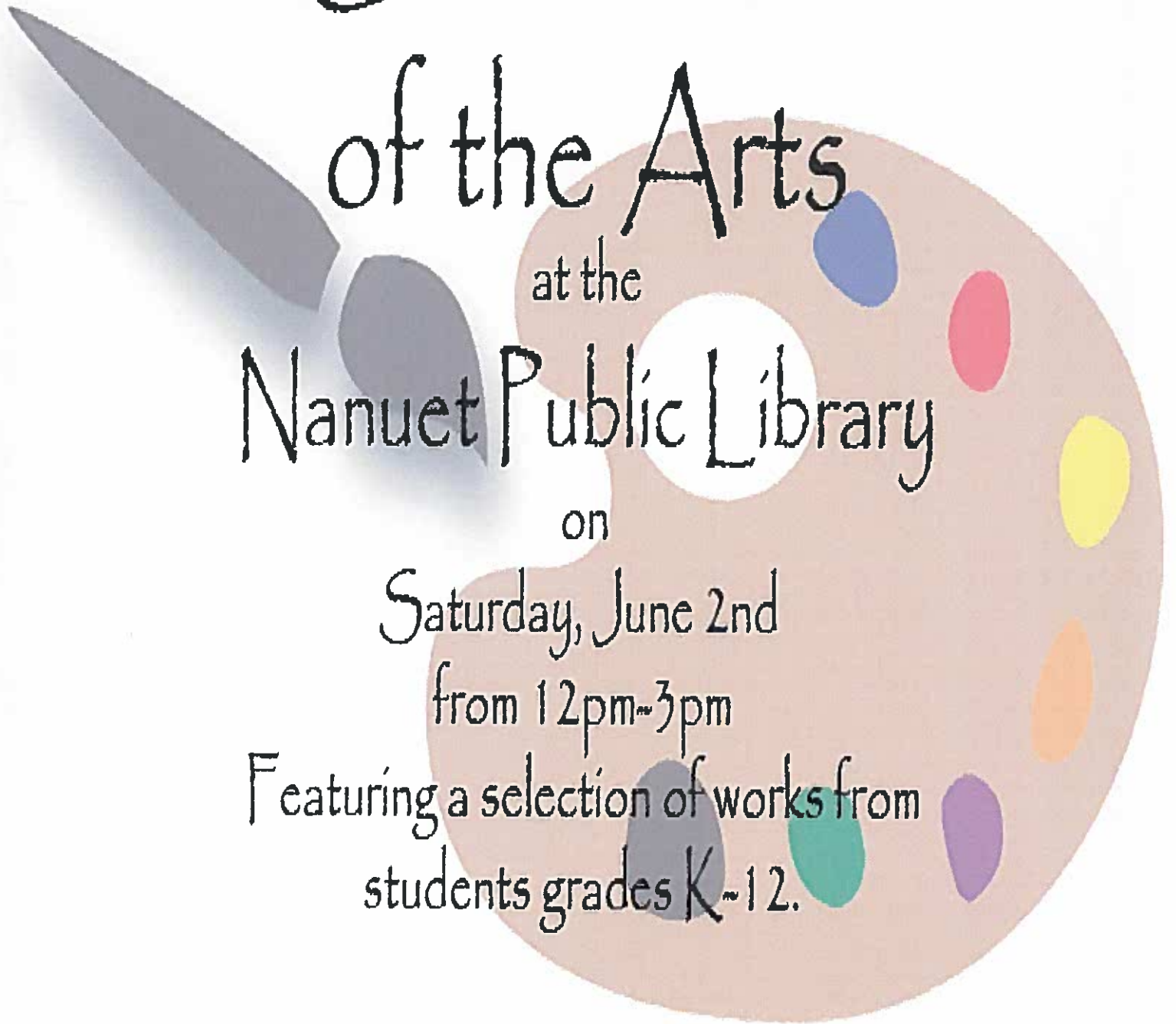

The Head Coach and organizer of the Nanuet Track Club is Sheri Dempsey.

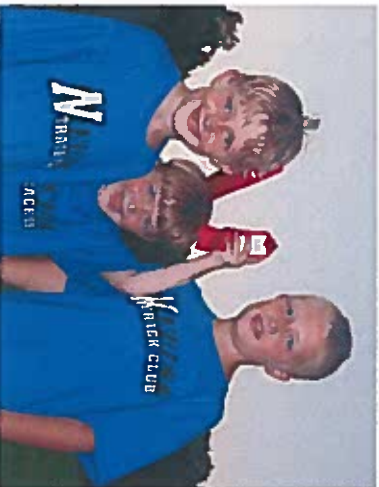


Nanuet Track Club Registration
