

**Code of Conduct and Dress Code  
For CYO County Dance at La Salle Academy Gymnasium  
Saturday, December 15, 2018 from 7:00pm to 10:00pm**

We want all students to have good, safe fun! Please read the following and sign if you wish to have your child participate.

- The dance is open to all 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students from Berks County Feeder Schools.
- Students will be dropped off for the dance at the rear entrance of La Salle Academy (Lot 2). A chaperone will be stationed there and assisting students into the dance.
- Up to two guests may be invited after providing guest information, see below.
- Students must respect others and obey all chaperones.
- Dress appropriately. See restrictions below.
- No foul language is allowed and that includes songs with bad words.
- Any physical contact that is not considered dancing is not permitted.
- No mosh pits. We do not want anyone to get hurt.
- Respect school property. Do not damage or take anything not belonging to you.
- Do not hang out in the bathrooms. Please take turns.
- Do not bring backpacks or other bags.
- Absolutely no tobacco, alcohol, drugs or inhalants
- Do not go onto the stage or near the DJ's "staging area" unless invited by the DJ.
- Cell phones are only permitted at the registration area and are only to be used for an emergency. There are no warnings. If a student is found using their cell phone, the cell phone will be confiscated and given to the parent when they pick up their child at the end of the dance.
- Prescription medicine cannot be administered by dance volunteers.
- No one is permitted to leave until the dance is over. If a parent needs to pick up a child prior to the end of the dance, we require that you come in and sign them out at the door or inform one of the chaperones. Otherwise, students will be dismissed to the rear entrance (Lot 2) parking lot at the end of the dance. Parents may also park in St. John's Church parking lot. We appreciate your promptness in connecting with them at this time. Instruct them, in advance, to return to the building if you are tardy at which time we would appreciate you meeting them inside the school. We want all children to be claimed safely and properly.

**NO to the following:**

- Short shorts, boxer shorts as outerwear, cut-off shorts, worn jeans with holes
- Exposed midriff, back or cleavage, halter tops, spaghetti straps or tube tops
- Muscle shirts, Hats or caps, skates or shoes with wheels and Laser lights
