Dear Eighth Grade Isaac E. Young Parent/Guardian,

Friday, June 22nd at 9:00 a.m. will mark your child's successful completion of middle school and the beginning of the exciting high school years. Our graduation ceremony will be held at New Rochelle High School in the Gymnasium. This facility is large enough to accommodate our families and has air-conditioning. (However, please be careful about heat sensitivity.)

Our graduates will wear academic caps and gowns (boys-green and girls-white) as we celebrate this traditional step to high school. We ask for your assistance in helping us make this a spectacular day.

Graduation Rehearsal is Thursday, June 21st at New Rochelle High School. Students are asked to meet our staff at the high school promptly at 8:30 am on the outside auditorium steps. After rehearsal, students will be dismissed to go home. Please make sure that your child has transportation to and from the high school.

The Graduation Ceremony is Friday, June 22nd at New Rochelle High School (9:00 am). On Friday, June 22nd students are to report to the New Rochelle High School auditorium at 8:15 a.m. to line up for the graduation march. All students are expected to dress appropriately, and comfortably.

Diplomas **will not** be given to those students who have not returned books and/or paid book fines. Students who are required to attend summer school, as they have failed a subject or more than one, will be given their Isaac E. Young diplomas when they have satisfactorily completed all eighth grade requirements. Students who **fail 2** or more academic subjects **will not be allowed** to participate in the graduation ceremony. Students who **fail 3** or more academic subjects may be held-over, and those parents/guardians should contact me immediately. Students who have been suspended multiple times or have been involved in serious disciplinary action **will not** be allowed to participate in graduation. This is school policy and any questions or concern should be directed to me.

Please contact your child's counselor if additional information is needed. We thank you for your support of Isaac E. Young over the years, and your continued cooperation, as we prepare for the closing of the 2017-2018 school year. Have a healthy, enjoyable, and productive summer.
