Dear Families,

We are entering the third marking period, and the year is quickly winding down. We spent the first two marking periods, September 2017 to January 15th, 2018 teaching students about behavioral expectations. Students learned what it means to be respectful to others, responsible for your actions, and ready to learn. We also spent a great amount of time teaching our students about bullying. Students learned what is bullying, what it means to be a bystander, and how to report acts of bullying. We are proud of our students, especially our 6th graders, who have become advocates for each other.

Please reinforce with your child the importance of following the rules and expectations of Isaac E. Young Middle School. **Lateness to class, loitering in the hallways, use of foul or inappropriate language, horseplay/rough play, running and screaming in the hallways, fighting, and bully behavior will not be tolerated.** Students who demonstrate these behaviors will receive consequences.

Depending on the offense, if a student chooses to ignore an expectation, we reserve the right to apply the following consequences, not limited to:

- **First** Consequence: Verbal warning and or act of restoration
- **Second** Consequence: Lunch detention and or act of restoration
- **Third** Consequence: 2-hour after school detention/2:30-4:30
- **Fourth** Consequence: Loss of privileges such as field trips and end of year activities
- **Severity Clause:** Suspension out of school for up to five days for severe acts such as fighting

Since **all** students have been taught the expectations and verbally warned, we reserve the right at this time of year, to implement second stage consequences or higher. We will notify you should your child receive an administrative office referral, detention, or suspension in or out of school.

We will continue to encourage and recognize appropriate behavior. Your support of our expectations is essential, and we look forward to working with you to ensure our students receive a high-quality educational experience. Our school counselors, social workers, and psychologists are available to provide you with educational or social emotional support. They are also able to provide information regarding community resources should you require additional assistance. Please do not hesitate to contact us for additional information.
