• **Title I:**

- ✓ Academic Interventions
- ✓ Staff Development activities for teachers and paraprofessionals
- ✓ Reach-In or Pull-out services for students in need provided by Title I personnel
- ✓ Parental Involvement Activities
- ✓ Family Centers (located at WSLES, RLES & GMLES) to provide support and assistance to children and their families
- ✓ Services and educational materials to students identified as homeless
- ✓ Materials of instruction and educational equipment

• **Pre-K - Title I - Part A**

- ✓ Pre-kindergarten classes for 4 year olds (in conjunction with other funding sources)
- ✓ Teachers, paraprofessionals, classroom equipment, materials, supplies, daily snacks, professional development for teachers and paraprofessionals

• **McKinney-Vento (Homeless) - Title I, Part A & Title X**

- ✓ Resources to support children and families meeting Homeless Criteria (school supplies, school uniforms, academic assistance and other family support services)
- ✓ Tutoring and Summer Programs
- ✓ Referral services to community agencies for assistance with housing, clothing, utilities, food, healthcare, etc.

• **Migrant Education Program - Title I, Part C**

- ✓ Recruitment Services
- ✓ Tutoring services for eligible migrant students
- ✓ Supplemental instructional materials
- ✓ Resources to support migrant families regarding family needs
- ✓ School supplies

• **Neglected and Delinquent Program - Title I, Part D**

- ✓ Instructional support services to students at the Juvenile Justice Facility who have been identified through the court system (tutoring, school supplies, professional development)
- ✓ Transition activities for students returning to public schools
- ✓ Summer Enrichment

• **Title II**

- ✓ Curriculum Specialist to provide support and assistance to teachers
- ✓ Staff Development activities
- ✓ Funding for Teacher Certification/Highly Qualified (reimbursements for college courses and stipends for professional development)
- ✓ Materials needed for successful completion of staff development activities
- ✓ Principal/Assistant Principal Leadership Trainings

• **Title III**

- ✓ Language Arts materials of instruction for students identified as English Language Learners
- ✓ PD activities to assist regular classroom teachers with servicing ELL students
- ✓ Online support for learning the English language

• **Title VII, Indian Education Program**

- ✓ Tutoring and educational materials to eligible Native American students and their families.
- ✓ Summer camps for eligible Native American Students that provide cultural enhancement and academic enrichment.
- ✓ Cultural activities such as drumming and regalia classes
