**At Home Locker**

- Place to organize the materials for each subject area
  - Folders (one for each subject, labeled)
- Pens/Pencils (for replacement throughout the year)
- Loose leaf paper
- Inexpensive earbuds or headphones
- Number 2 pencils (for replacement throughout the year)
- Expo markers- low odor (for replacement throughout the year)

**Personal Backpack**

- Chromebook (district will provide each student; fully charged at home)
- Lunch (if buying, all digital)
- 5 subject notebook (with folder dividers)
- Two heavy plastic folders (am folder, pm folder)
- Zip up Pen/Pencil Case
  - Inexpensive earbuds (to be kept in pencil case/binder)
  - Pens-black and blue
  - Number 2 pencils
    - 12 sharpened pencils in pencil case
    - Pencil eraser toppers (or handheld erasers)
  - Hand-held pencil sharpener with case to catch shavings
  - Calculator (Depends on math course):
    - Grade 6 Math: Basic 4 function calculator - Labeled with student's name
    - Grades 7 and 8 Math (non Algebra Honors students): Scientific calculator (prefer Texas Instruments Model #TI 30X IIS or a calculator with a 2-line display)- Labeled with student's name
    - Grade 8 Algebra Honors: Graphing calculator (prefer Texas Instruments Model #TI-84) - Labeled with student's name
  - Highlighters (2 different colors)
  - Colored pencils
  - Expo Markers- low odor (2)
  - Expo Eraser (or clean sock)
  - Ruler (one with cm and inches)
  - Scissors (child blunt tip)
  - Post Its (minimum 3 in x 3 in)
