

Grade 7 Team Supplies

As a team, we are requesting a **one 2-inch binder**, yet your child may be more comfortable with an accordion folder, separate folders for each subject or 2 binders (morning and afternoon). Therefore, as a parent, it is important to have a discussion with your child about his/her organizational needs. **In addition to the organizational system your child decides upon, the following items are required:**

General Supplies to Store in the Student's Zip up Pencil Case

- Zip up plastic pencil/pen case
- Inexpensive ear-buds (to be kept in pencil case/binder)
- Hand-held Pencil Sharpener
- Pens- black and blue
- 2 glue sticks
- Number 2 pencils (3 boxes)
 - 6 sharpened pencils in pencil case
 - One box of pencils (for Period 1 class)
 - Three boxes should be left in their locker, so they may refill throughout the year
- Pencil eraser toppers (or hand-held erasers)
- Highlighters (2 different colors)
- Colored pencils
- Ruler (one ruler with cm and inches)

General Supplies for the Binder

- Loose-leaf paper (in front of binder)
- 8 Plastic Folders – 1 for each core and exploratory subject (hole punched in binder)

General Supplies for the Period 1 Classroom

- 3 boxes of tissues

Math

- Scientific calculator (prefer Texas Instruments Model # TI 30X IIS or a calculator with a 2-line display)- **Labeled with student's name** –may be used the following year in grade 8
- Protractor (will be used in the Spring and can be left at home until then)
- 1 subject notebook

ELA

- Post Its (approx. 3 x 3) – 1 package
- 1 subject notebook

Foreign Language

- 1 subject notebook
- 2 plastic folders
- 1 additional set of inexpensive ear-buds to be kept in the classroom

Social Studies

- 1 additional set of inexpensive ear-buds to be kept in the classroom

Science

- 1 inch hard binder
- 3 index tabs
- Loose-leaf paper

If you are the type of student who likes to color code your materials, the following colors are assigned to each subject:

Red.....ELA

Purple...French

Yellow....Science

Purple...Spanish

Blue....Social Studies

Green.....Math
