Please see the back of this list for supplies specific to each 4th grade homeroom.

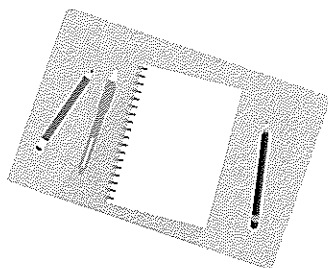
Here is a list of supplies ALL 4TH GRADE STUDENTS will need to start the year:

- 3 packages of **sharpened** pencils (keep more at home)
- colored pencils, maximum of 24, sharpened
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 4 **THIN dry erase markers** for whiteboards (keep extras at home), black, red, green, or blue and a small eraser for the whiteboard
- 2 large twist-up glue sticks (keep extras at home)
- 1 package square post-it notes
- soft pencil case to hold the above items (8½" x 5" or larger works well)
- 6 **bottom** pocket folders, as listed below:
 - 1 folder for homework (be sure it's durable)
 - 4 Plastic, durable folders should be colored: 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue.
 - 1 folder for music papers (a gently used folder is okay)
- children's scissors
- ruler with metric and US Customary markings to 12 inches
- 2 full size boxes of tissues
- Smock for art class recommended
- Earbuds or headphones **with a microphone** for computer use, in a **labeled plastic bag**
- Two large container of antibacterial wipes for cleaning surfaces

Our lockers are very narrow. Please keep this in mind when purchasing backpacks and lunchboxes. **Please do not purchase backpacks with wheels as they do not fit in the locker!**

Label **all** belongings. Even if you know what it looks like, the person who finds it may not know it's yours. Enjoy the summer. We'll see you soon! Remember to read every day to increase fluency and practice math facts daily so they are truly understood AND memorized!
