Monday | Grades 1 – 5 \$190

Sewing is excellent for hand/eye coordination, fine motor skills, focus and concentration, giving children a lifetime vehicle for personal and creative expression! All Sew Happy projects are designed in-house, made in the USA and use felt made from recycled water bottles.

Junior Chemical Engineering by Engineering for Kids

Monday | Grades K – 2 \$230

The Junior Chemical Engineering classes introduce our youngest engineers to fundamental concepts of solids, liquids, and solutions. Students investigate the properties of several crazy concoctions and make their own sample of bubbles, play dough, flub, and more.

Scratch Programming by Bricks and Motors

Monday | Grades 3 – 5 \$150

This interactive program introduces students to the amazing world of computer programming. Scratch is a graphical programming language that makes it easy to create interactive art, stories, simulations, and games – and share those creations online.

Children snap together graphical programming blocks to make characters move, jump, dance, and sing. Digital Drawing and Coloring by Digital Arts Experience

Wednesday | Grades 1 – 3 \$288

They will also use Wacom drawing tablets to draw on screen with different colors, brushes, and textures.
