



ICE SKATING 2019

New Rochelle Parks and Recreation is accepting registration for the 2019 Ice Skating Program

Dates: Fridays – Jan. 11, 18, 25, Feb. 1, 8, 15, March 1 and 8, of 2019 (*3/15 Make-up day*)
(8 sessions)

Time: Upon school dismissal @ 3:15 pm. Pick-up time is 5:45 pm at your school.

Fee: \$200.00

Site: Hommocks Park Rink – Mamaroneck, NY

Eligibility: 3rd – 4th – 5th graders

- Children will assemble immediately upon school dismissal (inside school – location TBD) under Recreation Staff supervision. The Recreation Staff will accompany the group on the bus, at the rink and back to school where they will be released to a parent or guardian @ 5:45pm. No child will be allowed off school grounds at this time without a parent/guardian – even if the child usually walks home from school.
- Children will be required to board the bus at the rink for the return trip to school. For families who wish to pick up their child at the rink, please submit this request in writing to Michael West or the recreation staff that is appointed to your child's school. Children will not be allowed to wait at the Hommocks Rink for a ride home. Any child (with or without a note) not picked up at the rink by 5:15pm will be required to board the bus back to school with their group.
- Participants may bring their own skates or rent skates at the rink for \$3.50. Please remember to send your child each Friday with his/her skates or exact cash in an envelope labeled **SKATE RENTAL**.
- The concession stand at the rink will be open if your child wishes to purchase a snack. Snack money should be separate and not included in your child's skate rental envelope.
- The program requires a minimum number of registrants in order to operate. If there is an inadequate registration, you will be notified and your fee will be returned (in full). Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis. A confirmation letter and a copy of this page will be sent to your home. No refunds will be issued after the first session whether or not your child has attended.
- A recorded cancellation message will be available on **654-2088** in the event of inclement weather. You will not be notified directly. Please do not tie up the school office phone lines to obtain skating information, call the number indicated above or **654-2087**.

THIS PROGRAM OFFERS SUPERVISED RECREATIONAL SKATE TIME, NOT INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTION. RECREATION AND RINK STAFF OFFER GUIDANCE, SUPERVISION, AND ENCOURAGEMENT TO PARTICIPANTS.

Completed application and registration fee (\$200) is due in the RECREATION OFFICE (not your child's school office) by Monday, January 7, 2019 by 4:00 PM unless all spots are filled before this date.

Ice Skating participants will meet the Recreation Staff in the school auditorium (or other designated location TBD) inside the school building at dismissal time before boarding the bus with the staff. Registration numbers are based on bus capacity and acceptable child/staff ratio.
