## Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Davis staff will be in place inside and outside of the school each day to supervise and assist students from 8:00 to 8:30 a.m. Parents and caregivers are expected to remain outside the building during arrival and dismissal to ensure a safe arrival and exit every day; this includes, of course, the main lobby just outside of the auditorium.

Students may arrive at school beginning at 8:00 a.m. If you need to leave your child earlier, we offer an affordable Early Drop-off program that begins at 7:15 a.m. each day in partnership with the Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle. ### Arrival – Good Weather

Students may be dropped off at the front of the school or at the gates behind the school on Grand Boulevard. Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade students can also be walked to the entrance just to the right of the playground on Iselin Drive.

**Kindergarten** and **1<sup>st</sup> Grade** students assemble on the blacktop and playground just outside the Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade classrooms. Students will be supervised closely by Security staff and the assigned Davis staff members/monitors. Parents and caretakers must remain outside of the fenced areas throughout. Children are free to play until 8:25, when they'll be asked to line up and wait for their teachers.

**Students in grades 2 through 5** assemble (play and socialize) in the back of the school, also supervised by multiple Davis monitors and staff.

**Class line-up spots** will indicate just where each class should wait to meet their teachers. Teachers will come outside each day to escort students indoors.

### Arrival – Inclement Weather

Davis staff will be in place throughout the school building to supervise and assist students when we must assemble indoors.

**Kindergarten** and **1<sup>st</sup> Grade** students may enter through the main doors or through the entrance between their playground and the blacktop. Davis staff and monitors will supervise students as they wait in the hallway just outside their classrooms. **3<sup>rd</sup> grade** students will assemble and wait for their teachers in the auditorium. **2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade** students will assemble and wait for their teachers in their respective hallways. Teachers will escort their classes to their classrooms at the 8:25 bell.

### Dismissal

Through the school day and after school, cars are not permitted to enter the circle in front of the school as so many students exit and cross the lawns every afternoon on their way home. Parents and caregivers are expected to wait outside to meet students; for safety reasons, only school staff is allowed inside the building from 3:00 to 3:25 p.m. If you are picking up your child early from school, please do so by 2:45 p.m.

**Kindergarten** and **1<sup>st</sup> Grade** classes will exit by the playground/blacktop areas in front of the K/1 wing. **2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade** classes will leave through the main doors in the front of the school. **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade** classes will exit out the doors leading to the lawn to the right of the main entrance. **4<sup>th</sup> Grade** classes will exit by the basketball courts. Davis staff will escort bus students directly to their buses each afternoon.

For this school year, **half day dismissal will be at different times on different days for elementary schools.** Please see schedule on our homepage and on the district calendar.
