- Examples include: "The Box Car Children" series, "The Magic Tree House" series, "Goosebumps" series, "Who/What was?" series, "Surviving" series, "The Little House on the Prairie" series, or there are several other options in the children's book section at the library.
- One book will be utilized to complete a reading activity during our first week of school. This will be a recorded grade. Be prepared to recall information from the book to complete the activity.
- Several novels are part of our 3rd grade curriculum. Please refrain from reading the following novels: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe, Nim's Island, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, The Best Christmas Pageant Ever, Mr. Popper's Penguins, Charlotte's Web, Ella Enchanted, and Ramona Quimby, Age 8.

Summer Math Practice

Your child should have already mastered all of the addition and subtraction facts. Multiplication concepts were also taught in 2nd grade. Students will need to work on multiplication facts 0-5 during the summer.
