Takeshi Kanno

On the afternoon of March 11, 2011, a 9.0 magnitude earthquake and the tsunami that followed destroyed villages and claimed thousands of lives in Japan. Doctor Takeshi Kanno was on duty at a local hospital when he heard the tsunami alert. In the brief time between the start of the earthquake and when the deadly wave hit, he moved dozens of patients to the highest floors and out of immediate danger. Over the next two days, Kanno stayed with those he'd helped rescue and continued to care for them until each one could be evacuated.
