Sonríoy saludo a la gente.

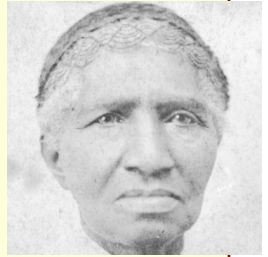
Muestro interés por los demás.

Clara Brown

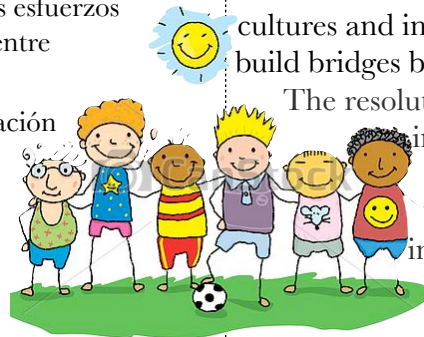
Born a slave, Clara Brown was sold at auction and separated from her family at age 35. Freed in her fifties, she traveled west from Kansas in search of her loved ones. It's believed Brown was the first black woman to cross the plains during the Gold Rush. She settled in Central City, Colorado, and successfully established a laundry. Clara's laundry profits allowed her to invest in the mines and property. Never turning away anyone in need, she used her investment earnings to help newly freed slaves rebuild their lives. At age 79, Clara traveled to Kansas to help even more freed slaves build their own community and farm the land.



Día Internacional de la Amistad
