  - Chancellor's Meeting Recap of Key Points
    - School Budgets
      - Although the budgets are not available yet, schools should anticipate a 3% Budget Cut.
      - Currently waiting to hear about funding from the Federal Stimulus.
    - CEP Extension – July 24<sup>th</sup>
      - Completion of these documents have been postponed to ensure that decisions are made with the budgets in mind.
    - Building Capacity
      - Each school was given a Preliminary Social Distancing Capacity plan indicate the capacity to ensure social distancing along with guiding questions when thinking and planning for next year.
