Arrival in the morning


Students will begin lining up outside the building no earlier than 8:15am.

Each grade has a designated entrance in the morning.

- Masks on!
 - Stand on paw print- 6 feet apart to maintain social distancing.
 - Rain or shine will be lining up outside.
 - Be mindful of community & people passing by- no congregating or gathering in small groups.
 - Temperature checks & screening at each entrance before entering the building.

6th grade AM Arrival

Exit 2- on Oceania
Street

Stand on white paw
prints to maintain social
distancing.

Masks on!

Wait for temperature
check/screening before
entering the building.



7th grade AM Arrival

Exit 11- on 47th avenue

Stand on gold paw prints to maintain social distancing.

Masks on.

Wait for temperature check/screening before entering the building.



8th grade AM Arrival

Exit 5- 8th graders will line up at the back of the school.

Stand on paw prints to maintain social distancing.

Masks on!

Wait for temperature check/screening before entering building.



After you enter the school, you will **go directly** to your classroom.

You must **follow the arrows** on the ground and along the walls as you walk to class.

Stairs are up only in the AM.

Please **stay 6 feet apart** at all times!



If you arrive late, you will enter school through the **main entrance**.

Your temperature will be taken and you will proceed directly to your classroom.

Dismissal

Students will be escorted to the closest exit by their classroom teacher.

- Exit 2- Oceania Street
- Exit 3- 46th Ave.
- Exit 5- School yard
- Exit 9- 47th Ave.



- Must wear mask
- Stay 6 feet apart
- Down only in stairwells
- Follow directions of teacher

Things to remember

in order to be successful

We must wear our masks at all times.

We must maintain social distancing- 6 feet apart in the hallway, in the classroom, before and after school.

DRY YOUR HANDS

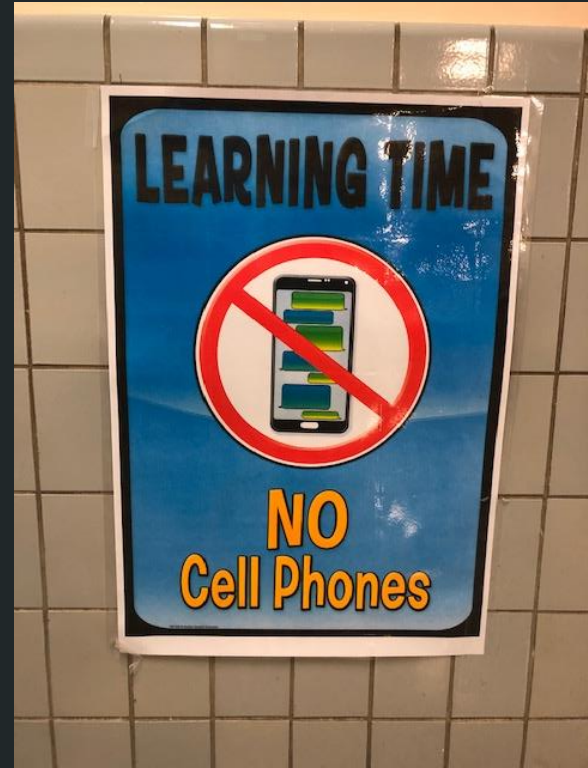


TURN OFF WATER WITH PAPER TOWEL

Whether you are a blended learner or a remote learner this year please remember to follow the digital expectations set by the school and your individual teachers.

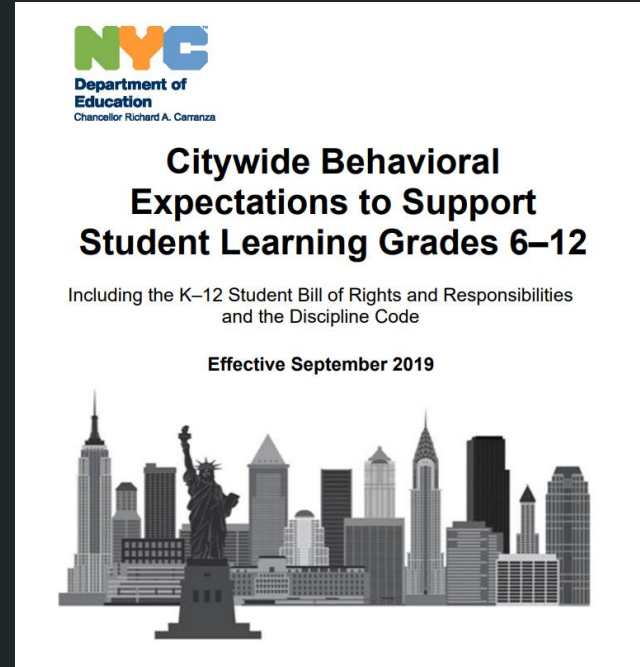
- You are expected to attend homeroom each morning and complete the attendance.
