Reading:

- **Children will be able to:**
- Develop and answer questions about a text
- Retell stories or share key details from a text
- Identify characters, settings, major events in a story, or pieces of information in a text
- Identify specific information to support ideas in a text

Writing: Children will be able to:

- Understand the process of procedural writing through teacher modeling and applying
- Use various resources to strengthen their writing skills
- Improve conventions of standard English such as capitalize the first letter in a sentence, spell simple words phonetically and end with punctuation

Math: Children will be able to:

- Find the missing part within an equation
- Count and write from 11-20
- Count forwards from a given number
- Count to find how many
- Find parts of number between 11-19

Science: Children will be able to:

- Understand a student's role as engineers
- Discuss and describe movement
- Explain force between two objects
- Discuss force and distance
- Working on building a class pinball machine
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Social Studies: Children will be able to:

- Identify what a landmark is
- Identify names of some landmarks
- Learn the difference between maps and globes
- Identify a compass rose and learn terms such as north, south, west, and east
- Learn what makes up NYC and learn about the five boroughs
- Learn how to locate the United States on a world map

Phonics: Children will be able to:

- Learn that digraphs are two letters put together to create a new sound
- Learn the sounds of sh, th, ch, ck, wh
