



## Grade 4

### October Goals

**Reading**– Your child will refer to details and examples in a text when explaining what the text says explicitly and when drawing inferences about character, setting, problem and solution from the text.

**Math**- Your child will multiply a whole number of up to four digits by a one-digit whole number, using strategies based on place value and the properties of operations. Also solve multistep word problems using the four operations, including problems in which remainders must be interpreted.

**Writing**- Your child will write a Personal Narrative by using dialogue and description along with vivid sensory details and a captivating lead and a satisfying ending to develop experiences and events for the characters, setting and plot.

**Science**: Your child will be able to classify Living and Nonliving things by identifying plant structures, how plants and animals reproduce, how living things adapt to their environment and why bird beaks differ.

**Social Studies**: Your child will explore the life of Native Americans in New York by comparing and contrasting the Native American groups that lived in different parts of New York and about the effects of the geography of New York on the first people who lived there.
