Reading

- Identify story structure
- Summarize a story
- Compare and contrast different texts and character traits
- Use questioning for comprehension
- Draw conclusions in a story
- Monitor and clarify text evidence

Writing

- To begin to write simple pattern books
- Use resources to improve writing
- Begin to understand that a sentence starts with a capital letter, has finger spaces, and ends with a period

Math

- Represent, count, and write the numbers 6-10
- Compare the quantity of two numbers up to 10 using vocabulary terms such as greater than, less than, same/equal
- Solve problems by using the strategy “make a model”

Science

- Identify matter as a solid, liquid, or a gas
- Observe and describe properties of objects
- Compare and sort objects based on observable properties
- Recognize physical changes of matter
- Observe, record, and discuss how matter can be changed by heating and cooling

Social Studies

- Explore self and others in a community
- Describe how people are alike and different by discussing physical traits, language, and culture
- Understanding/learning about the different holidays during the winter season
