Reading:

- Sequence the events in a story retelling the beginning, middle, and end
- Note key details in a text
- Make inferences and predictions based on text and prior knowledge
- Identify the author's purpose in a text stating whether the author is trying to teach or entertain

Writing:

- Finish up all about nonfiction writing by creating a nonfiction report
- Begin the process of "How To" writing where they will use words such as first, then, next, and last

Science:

- Understanding the needs of plants and animals

Social Studies:

- Understand how the physical environment affects how people live
- Understand how physical features of a community can change

Math:

- Solve subtraction word problems
- Use patterns to develop fluency in subtraction
- Fluently add subtract to to 10
- Solve word problems
- Find the missing parts

- Continue learning how to tap CVC words
- Learn about short and long vowel A
- Learn the "magic e" rule
- Learn the difference between statements and questions
