

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Nominations for President and Vice President shall be made by board members present at the annual organization meeting. If no nominee receives a majority vote of the members of the board present and voting, the nominations previously made shall be declared void and the nominations reopened.

Should the office of the President or Vice President become vacant, the board shall use the method of election set forth above to select a member to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term. The election shall take place within 30 days of such time as the office becomes vacant. Should both President and Vice President be absent from a meeting at which a quorum is present, the majority of the quorum shall appoint a presiding officer pro tem.
