

Video Surveillance

The Medford Lakes School District recognizes the district's responsibility to provide for the safety of the school community and for the protection of school district property. To maintain safe and secure conditions for all students, staff and property, the use of video surveillance equipment may be in place on school district properties and transportation vehicles used by its student.

1. The district shall notify its students and staff that video surveillance may occur on any school property or on any transportation vehicle. The district shall incorporate said notice in the student handbook and post it on all school properties and transportation vehicles.
2. The use of video surveillance equipment on school grounds and on other district properties shall be supervised by the district administration.
3. The use of video recordings from surveillance equipment shall be subject to the other policies of the district including policies concerning the confidentiality of student personnel records.
4. Video surveillance shall be used to promote the order, safety, and security of students, staff, and property. Recordings may be used in pupil and staff discipline matters and to provide evidence to law enforcement for investigation or prosecution purposes.
